Estabrook School Science Fair 2017 Participation Rules

- All Estabrook students grades K-5 are eligible to participate. Students must be enrolled at Estabrook.
- Students may participate individually or in teams. Each team may have up to four students. Each team member must complete their own registration form because parent approval is required for each student. There is a place on the registration form to indicate that the student is working in a group. Registration will be on-line this year. Find the sign up link here on the Science Fair page.
- Parent involvement should be limited. Parents may provide suggestions and guidance on ideas and process, but students should perform the work.
- An adult must accompany each participant or team at the Science Fair for the entire duration of the Science Fair.
- This is not a competition and no awards will be presented. Each student will be presented with a Certificate of Achievement by a Visiting Scientist.

Project and Display Rules

- No dangerous chemicals, dangerous materials should be used in your project.
 Absolutely no poisonous chemicals, heaters, flames, high voltages or hazardous materials will be allowed in the displays at the Science Fair. Remember children of all ages will be visiting your display and will be interested in your project.
- No messy displays or demonstrations are allowed.
- No distribution of food or food samples are allowed as part of the display because of food allergies.
- The Science Fair Committee volunteers reserve the right to deny any display that is dangerous or poses a safety risk.
- The experiment itself should not be performed during the fair. Battery-operated electronics used in the experiment may be brought to the fair. There will not be power supply available.
